1. The organisers/committee reserve the right to cancel or combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
2. The organisers **do not** accept responsibility for the loss or damage to horses, harness or vehicles, owners, drivers, passengers, spectators or any other persons or property whilst at or near the venue of this event.
3. The organisers reserve the right to alter or amend this programme in any way it deems fit without giving prior warning.
4. Height certificates will be required for those animals competing in classes with height stipulations.
5. Withdrawals from competition will be accepted with a vet certificate for a full refund less \$10 admin fee.
6. Protests in writing within 30 minutes of the competition ending accompanied by \$50 should be given to the ground jury. \$50 is non refundable if protest is dismissed. The ground jury's decision is final on all matters.
7. Blinkers – All equines must be wearing blinkers while in harness
8. Drivers aged 6-10 years are to be accompanied by an adult ACDS member holding a second set of reins
9. Drivers aged 11-15 years must be accompanied by an adult ACDS driver.
10. Driver 16-17 years may drive a pair of ponies but not horses or larger combinations.
11. Drivers under 17 years are under no circumstance allowed to drive a stallion.
12. It is recommended that junior drivers (17 years and under) wear an approved safety helmet while in a vehicle (driver or passenger)
13. It is recommended that all competitors have a suitably attired groom/handler available at all times.
14. All equines competing must be 3yrs old or over.
15. No classes will be held so please be ready.
16. Public liability insurance- Any person causing a claim to be made against the ACDS Inc. insurance policy is personally liable for the excess amount as determined by the insurance policy at the time of the incident (excess \$1000)
17. Strictly no dogs
18. No hay
19. Equines are not to be tied to a float which is not hitched to a car, truck or ute.

DEFINITIONS

NOVICE EQUINE

A NOVICE IS AN EQUID WHICH HAS NOT WON MORE THAN 4 FIRST PLACINGS IN A HARNESS EVENT AT ANY SHOW. (TURNOUTS NOT INCLUDED)

NOVICE DRIVER

A NOVICE DRIVER IS DEFINED AS A DRIVER WHO HAS NOT COMPETED IN MORE THAN 5 HARNESS EVENTS/SHOWS.

TURNOUTS

SINGLES AND MULTIPLES CAN TAKE PART IN THESE CLASSES

PERIOD TURNOUT

THIS IS A MODERN DAY PERIOD TURNOUT FOR AUTHENTIC AND NON AUTHENTIC TYPE VEHICLES. THE COSTUME ETC IS TO BE FROM THE "ERA" OF THE VEHICLE OR FOR THE "ERA" VEHICLE WAS DESIGNED UPON. THE "ERA" SHOULD BE DISPLAYED IN A NUMBER HOLDER IN PLAIN VIEW.

VEHICLES

- AUTHENTIC- ORIGINAL/AUTHENTIC VEHICLES
- AUTHENTIC TYPE- REPRODUCTION OF AN AUTHENTIC VEHICLE
- VICEROY OR SHOW BOX WAGON- FOUR WHEEL, PNUMATIC TYRES
- PLEASURE – SHOULD BE EQUIPPED WITH SUITABLE GEAR FOR A PLEASURE DRIVE IE; PICNIC BASKET, HALTER AND LEAD ETC.

STANDARD BRED CLASSES

HORSES ENTERED IN ANY OF THE STANDARD BRED CLASSES INCLUDING THE TURNOUT MUST BE SHOWN IN A SPIDER. STANDARD BREDS ENTERED IN THE OPEN CLASSES ARE PERMITTED TO USE A SULKY.

HANDY

OBSTACLES COULD BE USED IN THIS CLASS TO SHOW THAT THE EQUINE IS INDEED HANDY.

PLEASURE

THIS IS A RELAXED EVEN PACED EQUINE AT BOTH THE WALK AND TROT. THEY SHOULD STAND IN A RELAXED MANNER. NOT EXPECTED TO SHOW A LOT OF ACTION BUT SHOULD STILL BE A PLEASURE TO DRIVE.

CHAMPION

TO BE JUDGED FROM WINNERS OF NOMINATED CLASSES

RESERVE CHAMPION

TO BE JUDGED FROM REMAINING WINNERS AND SECOND PLACE GETTER TO THE CHAMPION.

SUPREME
