ANNUAL FOAL FUTURITY

The purpose of a Futurity is to demonstrate the breeder's ability to assess the potential quality of a foal **BEFORE THE FOAL IS BORN.**

Each Futurity consists of three nominations.

FIRST NOMINATION: This nomination is made prior to the mare foaling (unborn foal). The fee is usually paid by the 31st July preceding the breeding year in which the foal is born. The maximum time is to pay this fee though will be one month prior to foaling. At this stage the foal is nominated before birth and you are required to submit the Dam's name and breeding details. **The fee for this first nomination is \$5.00.**

SECOND NOMINATION: This nomination is to be made by the 31st July, before the foal becomes a yearling. They are then judged as yearlings at the Pinto Annual Show. **The fee for this second nomination is \$10.00.** Please note that the foal **MUST** be foal recorded with the Pinto Society for the second nomination to be effective.

THIRD NOMINATION: This nomination is made by the 31st July, before the pinto becomes a two year old. They are then judged again as two year olds at the Pinto Annual Show. **The fee for this third nomination is \$10.00.**

THE YEARLING FUTURITY IS JUDGED IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:

Pinto Colt or Gelding (1yr)
Pinto Filly
Solid/Appendix Filly

THE TWO YEAR OLD FUTURITY IS JUDGED IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:

Pinto Colt or Gelding (2yrs)
Pinto Filly (2yrs)
Solid/Appendix Filly (2yrs)
CHAMPION/RESERVE TWO YEAR OLD FUTURITY

ANNUAL FOAL FUTURITY

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All horses/ponies nominated in the Futurity **MUST** be foal recorded with The Pinto Horse Society (W.A.) Inc.
2. All payment must accompany each nomination on time and be lodged with the Registrar before the 31st July of each year.
3. The name of the Sire and Dam must be supplied, including the date of service, date of birth, name and address of owner. If the owner is not the breeder, the breeder's details will also be required.
4. All exhibitors of horses/ponies nominated in the Futurity must be financial members of The Pinto Horse Society (W.A.) Inc.
5. Each member may make as many nominations as they desire.
6. The breeding year date commences on the 1st August of each year.
7. Nomination forms must be completed and paid in full before the horse/pony is eligible to compete. No horse/pony can proceed through any stage of the event unless fully paid up for each and every previous stage.
8. First nominations (before birth) must be made by the owner of the mare. If the mare or foal is sold/leased, the registered owner/lessee can then continue on with nominations at each stage of the futurity.
9. A nomination for the second and third futurity stages cannot be made if the initial first nomination is not entered and paid.
10. Certificate of Foal Recording is to be available on the day of the Annual Show if so requested.
11. All horses/ponies that enter the Futurity must abide by the Rules & Regulations of The Pinto Horse Society (W.A.) Inc. and the Annual Pinto Show.
12. The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the judging. The judge's decision is final.
13. Horses/ponies must be entered in the owner's/lessee's name.
14. All two year old entries must be shown in suitable headgear.
15. All yearling and two year old entries **MUST** be branded with the breeder's brand.
16. A horse/pony does not have to compete at the yearling stage, but will still be eligible to compete as a two year old providing all nominations for each stage have been paid for by the due date.
