SHOW REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Monday 26 October 2026 - Please ensure you lodge your entries early. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. A copy of each horse's Registration papers and a copy of your current Membership card must be forwarded with your entries.

2. CONDITION OF ENTRIES

• SOCIETY'S LIABILITY:

Lodgment of an entry form is deemed to be acknowledgement by the exhibitor of his or her agreement that the organising committee accepts no liability for any accident, damage or illness to horses, riders, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Parking on the RAS Grounds is undertaken at your own risk and The Pinto Horse Society WA Inc accepts no liability for any damage or loss whatsoever.

• SOCIETY'S DISCLAIMER:

The attached Disclaimer MUST be completed and signed by all Exhibitors and accompany your entries.

• EXHIBITORS:

Must be financial members of the Pinto Horse Society WA Inc. In each case, the exhibitor must be the owner/lessee as recorded on the registration papers with the Pinto Horse Society WA Inc at time of close of entries.

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST ABIDE BY THE RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY.

• DOGS:

No dogs are permitted on the grounds, any exhibitor/spectator found with a dog will be asked to remove it immediately.

• EXHIBITS:

Must be Adult Registered or Foal Recorded within their appropriate age section of The Pinto Horse Society WA Inc.

• AGEING:

All Pinto's 3yrs of age & over must be adult upgraded. The age of the horse/pony shall be deemed as at the 1 August.

• ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES:

The Committee reserves the right to:

- reject or cancel an entry at any time
- cancel any event or class
- alter the time at which any class or event is to take place
- alter conditions of entry
- remove any exhibit/s from the venue
- transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to any other class
- split or combine any event or class
- empowered to substitute a judge

• NON-PINTO HORSE SOCIETY WA INC MEMBERS:

Non-Members must pay the Participants Fee of \$20. Non-members **MAY NOT COMPETE** in Handler/Rider or Driver classes.

• STALLIONS/COLTS:

No Stallion or Colt will be allowed to show without sturdy headwear. No Stallion or Colt can be handled by a junior 17 years & under, under any circumstances.

3. LODGMENT OF ENTRIES

• ENTRIES:

Must be on the official entry forms supplied by the society unless otherwise permitted by the secretary.

• ENTRY PAYMENT PLAN:

Must have the payment plan form filled out and attached to entries, A once off \$10 admin fee will apply to Weekly or fortnightly installments and to be paid to The Pinto Horse Society WA Inc, bank account,, Any monies still owing on close of entry date may forfeit entry, and money.

• FEES:

Must be forwarded with each entry. Please ensure that entry forms are correct, and the correct fees have been paid as incomplete entries WILL be automatically rejected. **No personal cheques will be accepted as payment.**

• REFUND:

Withdrawal of entries may only be refunded at committee discretion on presentation of doctor or vet certificate. Admin fee may be charged.

4. MANAGEMENT

- **PINTOS AT THE SHOW:**

No horse/pony shall be brought onto the grounds other than those entered in the show. The ground jury reserves the right to have any exhibit deemed to be dangerous removed from the grounds.

- **HEAD GEAR:**

All horses/ponies must be equipped with suitable head gear to facilitate safe handling at all times.

- **CRUELTY:**

Duty of Care to Animals ~The Pinto Horse Society will not tolerate any abuse of horses/ponies. ANY Pinto deemed to be behaving in a dangerous manner or deemed to be diseased, ill or in poor condition will be asked to vacate the grounds & forfeit all entries.

- **WHIPS:**

Maximum length of whips carried must not exceed 120cm.

- **PARENTS PLEASE NOTE:**

Children MUST be under YOUR supervision at ALL times & prams MUST be kept off the arena at ALL TIMES.

- **PROTESTS:**

An exhibitor/competitor may protest against an award won by an exhibit/competitor. This protest must be given in writing, giving reasons for the protest and duly signed, not more than 1 hour after the completion of the judging of the event. NO complaint will be attended to unless the \$100 deposit is paid at the time of lodging the complaint with the Show Committee. If the protest is unfounded, frivolous or vexatious, the \$100 deposit will be forfeited.

5. STABLES and FRONT GATE

- Gate 8 open's at 6.30am

- Bunkrooms Available, Bunkroom & Stable allocation available from 2pm Friday 13th NOV.

- STABLES- All stables MUST be cleaned before you leave the grounds & manure/feed placed in receptacles provided. This ALSO applies to the aisle way in front of your stable & any locker you are using or you will forfeit your \$20 stable bond. Once a committee member inspects all stables you will be refunded your bond via bank.

- Please pick up your manure, used feed & rubbish,

6. GENERAL RULES

- The Show Committee has the right to have an exhibit submitted for measuring.

Any person behaving in a rude, abusive, threatening or derogatory manner to any other person WILL NOT be tolerated & you may be asked to leave the grounds, you will then forfeit ALL of your entries.

- **The decision of the judge will, at all times, be final.**

- Competitors are advised that classes will not be held up under any circumstances. Please listen to your gate Marshall. All competitors must have their horses/ponies at the appropriate ring no less than 5 minutes before the start of each class.

- **Brood mare classes** – Mare MUST be currently in foal or foal at foot, Foal at foot must have head gear worn and have a handler. No free running foals on the grounds.

- **Best Marked** : The pinto which has the closet 50% white & 50% colour body markings.

- **Characteristic Classes:** The Pinto which has the most of the below characteristics should be awarded the higher place. Blue Zone/Shadowing, White Under The Jaw, Two Tone Genitalia (Males = sheath, testicles & anus. Females = udder, vulva & anus), Blue Eyes, Star, Stripe, Snip, Blaze, Two Tone Mane ,Two Tone Tail, Striped Hooves.

- **Pinto Futurity : Futurities – Must be nominated prior to birth.**

- To enter these classes you must have nominated the foal.

Foal must be nominated twice , first before birth and second time after birth, no less than 4 weeks old, and the foal is shown as a yearling (1yo) and then the following year shown as a 2yo,

There is a nomination fee, which goes towards to prize pool for the futurity classes at the state show

- **Veteran** - any registered Pinto , Solid, Appendix or Pintaloosa over the age of 15 yrs.

- **WESTERN SHOWMANSHIP:** Western Attire eg: Western Hat, Long sleeve Western Shirt or Western Jacket, Jeans or Black Slacks, Gloves, boots must be worn, Horse must be presented in Western Show Halter or Leather Halter (No Bit) is accepted, no makeup, not plaited, banded is preferred, NO WHIPS ALLOWED

7. RIDDEN GUIDELINES

- **LEADLINE:**

Open to Riders who are between the ages of 3 years and up to & including 10 years of age. Pony/Horse must be on a Lead that is attached to Noseband, cannot be attached to the bit. Simple Snaffles (egg butt or rings only) are permitted. Whips & Spurs are NOT permitted.

- **CHIDS FIRST RIDDEN:**

First year out competing un aided, Must be able to do walk, trot and canter, Open to riders 3yrs and under 10 years of age. Pony to wear a Snaffle bridle with cavesson noseband only. NO SPURS, Whips must not exceed 40cm. Ponies will walk and trot on the circle and canter can be asked for in individual workouts only. The rider is only eligible to compete in First Ridden classes. The pony may, however, compete in other classes with a second rider. First Ridden rider not to have competed in any open official competition other than first ridden or rider class.

- **WALK TROT :**

The walk trot classes are for **1.** the older horse who can't or struggles to canter any more. **2.** the rider who is older and/or physically unable to canter any more. **3.** The young green horse who has not competed at a show.

The Horse must not be cantered at any time while on the grounds, if entering walk trot you can not compete in open ridden class, this is walk trot only.

- **RIDDEN CLASSES :** Can only compete in walk trot **or** open ridden classes, can not enter both.

- **NEWCOMER:**

First year out competing for Horse/Pony, has not competed in any ridden event prior to the 2026 WA Pinto State Championships.

- **SHOW HUNTER:**

Minimal quarter marks & make up permitted. Approved safety helmets MUST be worn, NO top hats. Simple double bridle or snaffle bridle with plain brow band & noseband. Tweed jackets or plain navy or black fabric are acceptable. No cutaways or mini tails. Hair neat & tidy & worn in hair net if long, accessories should not be obtrusive, makeup should be tasteful.

- **Pony Club Mount and Adult Riding Club Mount** must be in their club uniform and have a copy of their club membership with entries.

“THE DESERT STUD” HIGH POINT BREEDERS AWARD



The Pinto Horse Society added this award in 2013 on behalf of Mrs. Dot Webber of Desert Stud. Dot Purchased her first pinto Desert Rose , and she was the first mare to be registered in WA under Pintos Australia(APtHA)in 1974 Dot bred and competed with her Pintos in most disciplines, including show jumping with the original stud stallion Desert Dust(purchased from Coolawanya Station), he being the foundation to the whole stud. Of course producing coloured stock of good quality is any Pinto breeders wish, but Dot always managed to have those coloured foals that did well at halter and under saddle. Desert Flame and Desert Escort being home bred stallions who were both Royal Show Supreme Champions. This award is to commemorate one of our founding members and breeders who put us on the right track to be where we are today, The Pinto Horse Society WA inc.

Horses/ponies MUST be bred by the Stud, NOT just named under that Stud name.

This is a Breeders Award, so any horse/pony entered who is Bred by the Stud goes towards the Breeders Award.

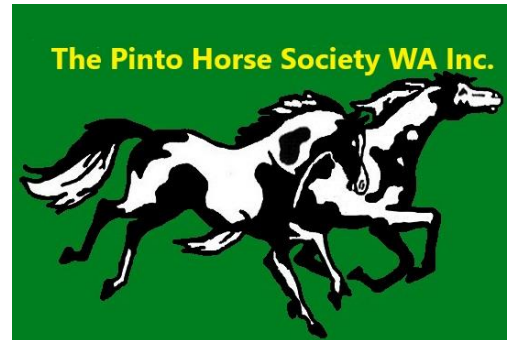
